The poster must be Letter-sized (8.5 x 11 inches); with a resolution: of 150 dpi; Portrait orientation; in jpg/pdf format; and RGB color mode. 4. Digital media resources (graphics, vector images, and pictures) downloaded from the internet are not allowed. Copyright information & permission used for images or other items must be fulfilled**. The video should include morals and lessons beneficial to the young generation, aspects unique & universal and points of pride. OR 2. Share any event from Ramayan. The video should include what's special or how it brought about change in your life.	1. Create a video on any one of the topic provided. 2. All video content must be original. 3. May use any method to capture or create moving images. 4. The production credit page should include sources used to research, development and design process; use of different video techniques; a list of equipment and software used; and copyright information for pictures, music, or other items**. 5. Video may be no longer than 2 minutes .
