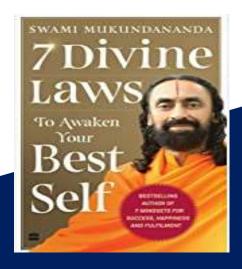

Summary of Main Points




- Creation's plan is the evolution of the soul towards perfection.


A typical ...!

Humans vs. Animals

Let us Recap!

- · Victor was born in penury in a slum colony.
- When he was fifteen years old, his schoolteacher declared to him, 'Victor, you are a dunce. You will never amount to anything in life.' Convinced of his stupidity, Victor dropped out of school.
- For the next seventeen years, he engaged in menial works.
- As part of the army selection process, they tested his IQ. His score went beyond the scale (161), which meant he was a genius. That one piece of knowledge transformed his life.
- He became an expert in lumberjack technology and wrote books on the trade. He also researched the topic of Intelligence Quotient, and became an expert, writing widely popular books on it.

Why Celestial Devtas desire human form?



Why do Celestial Gods desire it? Is it beautiful? No

- We do compare: Eyes like Fish, waist like a tiger's; Neck like a pigeon;
 Nose like a parrot
- However, human form is a bag of waste: if someone opens any stomach, the foul smell will make one vomit; Humans have every pore giving out waste!
- Devatas have so much fragrance, humans will faint
- They have a divine body not of panch mahabhuta, but of tejas;
 fragrance faint; Devtas body does not touch earth, no hunger or thirst;
 No shadow, their eyes don't blink! & no waste output from body
- Devtas praise those who got human form and birth in Bharat
- Devtas have much more power of knowledge than us! (e.g., weapons)
- Fact: we all have been dog, cat and even Indra innumerable times



- Karm Yoni (Human Form) vs. Bhog Yonis (all other forms)
- *All* want this body to be able to do sadhana and get out of the cycle.




But is Human Form really good?



Kaag Bhushundi & Garud ji samvaad: nar tan sam nahin kavaniu dehi. jiv charachar jachat jehi || narak svarg apabarg niseni. gyan birag bhagati sukh deni

- 1. Why did Tulsidas ji say Human form is incomparable He did NOT SPECIFY in good and bad way!
- 2. Why did Tulsidas ji say "Narak" as first option!
- ➤ He is being very clever! **Best** form: only opportunity to realize our goal and move forward. **Worst** form: since we will almost be forced to go wrong direction if we do not move in right direction
- Most humans will do sin & go to Narak. More intelligent do good deeds for Swarga & the real **smart do Bhakti**. This is the ONLY body which has KARM and BHOG. If we do not put this body in good direction, it goes in –ve direction with great speed! A dog, cat etc. can not steal or do theft like a human being does with intelligence (Gyan).

Akrur said: "Our intellect is strapped with wrong knowledge.





Anitya (not eternal)

Anatma: "Modern" Science???




If science is believed, then we a combination of atom and molecules. Then consider the following!




1. Where does <u>free will come from?</u>Does a machine have choice? A robot?
