

But what of those who don't want material results?


Then he moved on..doing duty doesn't not help us attain ultimate enlightenment..

by understanding that worldly things are nit my goal what I'm seeking is spiritual treasures..to develop dispassion one needs to cultivate knowledge..

It is called karm yog/ Shri Krishna called it buddhi yog..yoga of the intellect..

He asked Arjun to cultivate knowledge where binding works are no longer binding..and become liberating works..



So when Shris Krishn asked Arjun to cultivate knowledge Arjun became confused..

Arjuna is saying - By making contradictory statements, you are bewildering my intellect. I know you are merciful and your desire is not to baffle me, so please dispel my doubt.

Action?





When we acquire knowledge of something we can achieve it Large part of human endeavor is in Acquiring knowledge



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What is proper spiritual knowledge?






- With our own limited capacities, we reach out and learn more and more like in scientific endeavor. Basis of modern science
- However, this ascending process is subject to many deficiencies.. truth in one age dis approved in another age..
- Knowledge is built incrementally over time
- Limited knowledge ;relies on direct perception alone ;doesn't provide answers to afflictions ailing humans since time eternity

The more I learn, the more I realize how much I don't know - Albert Einstein



What is means is that ascending process is repeatedly getting corrected..so we do not know whether the knowledge that we accept as truth today will still remain a truth after 200 or 300 years... To understand spiritual knowledge through ascending process may take centuries and we human beings have limited time!

- The vedas talk of a difference process of knowledge: descending process
- You access a perfect source of knowledge and you simply receive..Without much labor..you immediately get access to the perfect knowledge...
- This descending process is utilized even in this material world...
- Vedas says it is to your benefit to use descending process
- The only point here is that source of knowledge must be perfect!This perfect source is the vedas



- Based on scriptural knowledge
- > Reiterated by multiple saints
- > Time tested universal principals
- **KNOWLEDGE** Presents a manual for human life

Descending Process



They are not the name of a book!they are the eternal knowledge of God that was passed down by hearing tradition..from master to disciple..that is why another name for Vedas is **shruti or knowledge that came through the ear..**



Only 5000 years ago Ved Vyas who was himself a descention of God..put it down in writing for the benefit of human kind..

In our vedic tradition of our Indian culture..these vedas are considered the reference point **bhutam bhavyam bhavishyan cha sarvan vedat prasidhyati**..the validity of any spiritual principle..is establhsied at the authority of the vedas..if it is corroborated accept it..if it is not..then there is scope for doubt..



These vedas, in order to explain their meaning a number of other scriptures were manifested by the realized saints..

Vedic literature: prasthan trayayi. three starting points to understand vedic thought...

Upanishads (over 200)

Great acharyas have written commentary on the upanishads..

Praised around the world

However these are difficult to understand..

Brahm Sutra Also called Vedant Darshan

Philosophic thoughts of vedas in very short aphorisms..called sutras..

Great Jagatgurus wrote their commentaries..on the meaning of these sutras..it is also deep philosophic thoughts which keeps it out of reach of common people..

BhagavadGita

Summary of all vedic philosophy..presented to us by Ved Vyas..

Dialogue that took place on the battle field of Kurukshetra..between the supreme Lord Shri Krishan and his devotee Arjuna..

Arjuna is perplexed by the situation he faced and he surrenders to the Lord to find the answers and solutions to the problems at hand..

Supreme Lord not only gave solutions to his immediate problems but he also divulged to explain the philosophy of life..and in the discussion he presented the deep science of God realization..



Amongst people interested in the spiritual path

there are those who are inclined toward contemplation

there are those inclined to action

The first is the acquisition of knowledge through the analytical study of the nature of the soul and its distinction from the body. Shree Krishna refers to this as *sānkhya yog*.

People with a philosophic bend of mind are inclined toward this path of knowing the self through intellectual analysis. The second is the process of working in the spirit of devotion to God, or karm yog. Shree Krishna also calls this buddhi yog

Working in this manner purifies the mind, and knowledge naturally awakens in the purified mind, thus leading to enlightenment.




Does spiritual knowledge lead to "religious fanaticism"?

- My path is superior etc.


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
